- 3. Exceptional items (pertaining to the previous year):

During the previous year, due to challenging market conditions in the spinning industry, the Company decided not to proceed with the greenfield expansion project, which had been approved by the Board of Directors (BOD). The land allotted for the project was surrendered, and as per the agreement, a surrender fee of 20% of the land premium (Rs. 7.68 crores) was written off. Additionally, lease rent and other expenses amounting to Rs. 0.77 crores were written off. The total amount written off, Rs. 8.45 crores, has been disclosed as an "Exceptional items".

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited consolidated financial results of Sutlej Textiles and Industries Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Parent"), and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") for the quarter ended 31 December 2024 and year to date results for the period from 01 April 2024 to 31 December 2024 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's management and approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "*Interim Financial Reporting*" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, to the extent applicable.

Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review report of the other auditor referred to in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

2. Exceptional items:

(a) As at 31 March 2024, the Company carried out an impairment assessment of its investment in a wholly owned subsidiary (including a step-down subsidiary) in accordance with Ind AS 36 and compared the carrying value of investments with their recoverable amounts. The recoverable amount was determined based on the value in use derived from a discounted forecast cash flow model performed by an independent valuer. The carrying amount of the investment in the wholly owned subsidiary (including the step-down subsidiary) was determined to be higher than its recoverable amount, and an impairment loss of Rs. 10.51 crores was recognised during the year ended 31 March 2024.

During the nine months ended 31 December 2024, due to lesser sales than the budget, the Company has decided to further reduce the recoverable value. Accordingly, an impairment loss of Rs. 6 crores has been recorded in these financial results.
